ABOUT ONLINE CLASSES

Free Virtual Classes During the COVID-19 Pandemic

Learn to use the HSR bus system safely during COVID with CAT. This program is open to individuals who currently access disability services in Hamilton. In a series of free online classes that run from 4 to 10 hours (depending on course options), participants are taught about safety and how to navigate the city's bus routes. Classes range in size from 4 to 20 participants and offer individualized attention. Course options are tailored to meet the needs of both new and previous CAT participants to cover all aspects of bus use and personal safety in the community during the pandemic.

Community Access to Transportation

The Community Access to Transportation project is a program that trains adults and youth aged 16 and older with disabilities in Hamilton to ride the bus independently for essential trips.

Community Access to Transportation was built by the Developmental Services Transportation Committee, a group of people who work in developmental services agencies across Hamilton.

These are some of the skills that will be taught in class:

- Planning a trip
- Travelling safely in the community
- Bus riding basics
- Problem solving
- Personal safety
- How to use PRESTO
- Travelling safely during COVID-19

COMMITMENT REQUIRED

Each weekly session includes between 4-10 hours of online learning. Classes will be split up into two hour classes multiple days per week. We currently offer three different session options.

Option 1 (approx. 8-10 hours total) In-depth, plain language travel training lessons

Option 2 (approx. 4-5 hours total) Plain language travel training lessons

Option 3 (approx. 4-5 hours total) Travel training lessons

All sessions include a Travelling Safely During COVID-19 lesson.
